



# COVID SAFE PLAN

## Somerset College Debating 2021



The following provisions must be taken to ensure the safety of all students and staff at Somerset College Debating.

- **Anyone feeling unwell** with symptoms of COVID-19 – fever, dry cough, trouble breathing, or sore throat – **must not attend debating at Somerset College**, no matter how mild those symptoms may be
- All attendees must register online using the provided QR code, which will be posted up at each debating event
- All attendees must observe any additional preventative measures posted as signage around the campus
- All staff, adjudicators, and any other **adults present at debating must observe 1.5 meters physical distancing**, including waiting to pass through doorways one person at a time and sitting separately in classrooms
- Hand sanitiser is provided in all rooms where debating is taking place
- Staff members must not share equipment or writing utensils
- **Toilet and handwashing facilities are available to all at the far end of the Gallus building**
- Signage at the venue reminds all present of their obligations under this COVID Safe Plan
- Somerset College Debating Coordinator is the qualified COVID-19 COORDINATOR, having completed *Infection Control Training – COVID 19*, and is on-site at all times to ensure provisions are adhered to.
